7. Project Description :

The Davao City Community-based Solid Waste Management Project (DSWMP) generally aims to significantly reduce the increasing volume of solid waste produced by the City of Davao through community-based collection and recycling practices and composting. Specifically, the project shall seek to develop an economically and financially viable community-based waste exchange and recovery program that will ultimately redound to the benefit of the households. The project's key success is anchored on the economic benefits derived in sorting and segregating the solid waste from the households up to the materials recovery center in every barangay. As a business enterprise, the project should be able to provide continuing employment to the residents of the barangay. Through this system, the barangays can slowly become independent in managing their solid waste problem without having to blame the City Government for inadequate service on the collection and disposal of the waste generated.

8. Beneficiaries : 15,209 households from eight contiguous barangays in Toril District namely: Bangkas Heights, Crossing Bayabas, Daliao, Lizada, Lubogan, Marapangi, Sirawan and Toril Poblacion
9. Expected Results :
- Households are segregating their wastes
  - Increase in number of cooperative members
  - Wastes recovered are recycled
  - Increase in income of the cooperative and its members
  - Households are earning from sale of recyclable waste materials
  - Proper segregation is being done
  - LGUs are trained and oriented on their role in the project
