7. Project Description :

The project will be conducted in selected urban poor communities in Paranaque City and Mandaluyong City in the National Capital Region and in the rural communities in the provinces of Laguna, Batangas and Rizal in the Southern Tagalog Region. The Project hopes to contribute to the improvement of the living conditions of families or communities affected by Typhoon Milenyo through agriculture assistance, rehabilitation of community facilities such as day-care centers and providing livelihood assistance to help them recover from their economic losses. The project is also aimed at providing education and training activities on disaster management work and disaster preparedness to communities affected by the typhoon and other communities vulnerable to disasters.

The project will have the following components:

- Micro-finance and Women's Livelihood in Barangay Sto. Nino, Riverside, Paranaque City
- Repair of Day Care Center in Sitio Manggahan, Barangay Old Zaniga, Mandaluyong City
- Agriculture Assistance in Barangays Sta. Ines, Tanay, Rizal
- Agriculture Assistance in Barangay Mamuyao, Tanay, Rizal
- Agriculture Assistance in Barangay Sampaloc, Pagsanjan, Laguna
- Agriculture Assistance in Barangay San Benito, Victoria, Laguna
- Goat Dispersal in Barangay. Masapang, Victoria, Laguna
- Repair of Macalamcam Kiddie School and Agriculture Assistance, Macalamcam, Batangas
- Medical Mission
- Disaster Preparedness Seminars
