## Peace Fund: Call for Proposals

Greetings!

The **Peace Fund** is a small project facility which can provide support to civil society peace and democratic governance efforts for Mindanao. It will provide the Canadian International Development Agency (CIDA) with the means to support small development projects designed to advance peace-related development initiatives.

The **Peace Fund** invites applications from civil society organizations for innovative projects that promote peace in development in Mindanao in the following thematic areas of effective democratic governance:

- a. Promotion and protection of human rights of women, children and vulnerable groups
- b. Capacity development of peace advocates and other stakeholders in the GRP-MILF peace process
- c. Community-based or indigenous conflict resolution mechanisms
- d. Community engagement in local decision-making processes
- e. Improved access to justice particularly for women and marginalized groups
- f. Law & policy reform advocacy

Grants range from Cad\$25,000 to Cad\$50,000 (approximately Php1M to Php2M). Applicants must meet specific requirements and proposals should respond to the needs in Mindanao. All initiatives undertaken with this mechanism will contribute towards the achievement of expected results of the Peace Links Program and to the broader CIDA Philippines program interim strategy.
